## **The Occupational Safety and Health Division of Department of Consumer and Business Services (DCBS):**


- Inspects places of employment
- Helps employers identify and eliminate hazards
- Investigates workplace fatalities/accidents/complaints
- Provides technical resources and training to workers and employers through outreach and public education
